HEROES #FORTHEBURG



Salonique Adolphe with Living Water Christian Mission in Haiti "For the past twenty years we have been engaging in transforming Haitians and Haiti through Jesus Christ. Some of you have been with us from the beginning and others have joined us at one point or another in our history. There are churches — many of them are small Churches — who have poured themselves into Living Water to positively impact hundreds of thousands of Haitians. Many — like mom and dad Green and John and Helen Meyer — have gone home since we started

In the course of this time children have received a quality education from preschool to College, souls were won unto Christ through the preaching and the teaching of the gospel, people's faith have been strengthened, people's health have been restored through the health clinic and the mobile clinics of foreign missions teams and nationals. We have fed millions of meals in different regions of Haiti and built homes. We have done all of those things together. We have an unfinished job that we need to continue to work on, let us do it together!

This Fall, once again, several thousands of children will resume their school education through our four main schools in Gonaives, Marmelade, Highland, and White Mountain. Major works need to be done in all four locations..."


